#### **ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS**

Public Comments: Non-Agenda Items (limited to 3 minutes per individual)

Mr. Noakes referred to Phase 3 and recalled that the CDD owns the sprinkler box controllers wired out to all the lots but he has not observed that at this time. It was noted that is not part of this contract. He asked if the CDD controls the irrigation system. Mr. Adams stated that the CDD controls the flow but each unit has control over its individual system. Mr. Noakes voiced his belief that the CDD owns the master controllers that are now inside the homes and that the CDD schedules the watering times and periods.

Discussion ensued regarding the main line, master controller, use of reclaim and well water, a master valve that serves the point of connection to each lot, the CDD control of the valve to the lot, property owner control of managing the system on their individual lots, etc.
