REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT AND LOSS OF REVENUE Submittal Date 10/02/2025

As the Board is aware, the Windward at Lakewood Ranch Community Development District is in litigation with Jon M. Hall and Company. Over the past several months myself and Chuck Adams have spent time in Zoom Hearings. Meetings and Court hearings via Zoom. While this has not caused my any travel related expenses, it has interfered with some other CDD Board Meetings for Boards I sit on. This obviously lost me revenue but I am not looking for recovery on that.

What I am looking for is dealing with upcoming trial dates that I will be requesting travel reimbursement on. One Date that will cost me a loss of revenue is for a Zoom hearing on October 6 and a meeting of the Grace Key Groves CDD that I will have to miss. That would be a loss of \$200,00 as I'm sure the Board understands. If the meeting does not occur for any reason than I would not expect any reimbursement for lost revenue. In additions I am requesting mileage reimbursement of 161 miles for travel at \$.70 a mile (current mileage rate from the IRS for 2025) for \$62.40 for the Jury Selection hearing at the Sarasota Court house on October 10.

The next time frame is very extensive. The actual trial is set to run all day from October 13, through the 24 at the Sarasota Court House. I will be traveling back and forth each day. I have a diabetic cat that needs insulin shots twice a day. I cannot leave her for more than a few days without her insulin. Therefore, I am requesting the Board consider the travel mileage as a per diem travel expense. I plan on renting a car for that time frame to keep mileage off of my personal leased vehicle. So I would aske for reimbursement of \$64.40 for each day of the trial or the actual daily rate of the rental which ever is cheaper.

Lastly I have the following CDD Meeting scheduled during the trial period as follows:

Twisted Oaks CDD

10/13/2025 Hammock Oaks CDD

10/14/2025 Deerbrook CDD

10/16/2025 Waterset South CDD 10/17/2025 Summit View CDD

Summit View II CDD

10/21/2025 Estancia at Wiregrass CDD (I am not a Board member for this CDD but I am a Board Consultant at \$200 per meeting.

Certainly as with the CDD meeting on October 6, I would only look for loss of revenue reimbursement for those CDD's that actually meet.

I realize that Chapter 190.06 (8) (see below) does not address loss of revenue for a Board Member. The Statute however certainly did not anticipate such an extended time commitment as laid out above. I have included Counsel on this also for their input. I do however respectfully request that this reimbursement for travel and loss of revenue be approved.

NOTE:

190.06(8) Each supervisor shall be entitled to receive for his or her services an amount not to exceed \$200 per meeting of the board of supervisors, not to exceed \$4,800 per year per supervisor, or an amount established by the electors at referendum. In addition, each supervisor shall receive travel and per diem expenses as set forth in s. 112.061.
